To nominate an individual(s) organizations must submit a detailed, written account (300-word synopsis or less) of the activities and accomplishments of each nominee. Accomplishments shall be considered for the current year only – from January 1 through December 31, 2021. Activities to be included should be community service and/or betterment, service to schools and youth, support of the arts, church involvement and professional involvement. Name, address, telephone number, and email address should be included for each nominee. Along with the synopsis organizations should submit two (2) letters of recommendation supporting the nominee.

Nominee(s) must reside within the immediate area of the city of Ozark or Dale County, or work in Ozark or Dale County, and community service must be performed within this geographical location.

Each organization may nominate one man and one woman for this prestigious award.
